7. HONORARY MEMBERSHIP

- a. Visitors may be admitted by the Committee to the Club as Honorary Members for a period not exceeding three (3) months, during which time they shall enjoy all the privileges of the Club except voting at meetings.
- b. For services rendered to the Club or for any other reason a person may on the recommendation of the Committee and the unanimous vote of all financial members at a General Meeting, be elected as an Honorary Member with full privileges, without fees or subscriptions for a period to be determined by the Committee.
- c. The Competition Secretary, and his/her assistants have the power to appoint persons as competition officials for the purposes of assisting in the conduct of events under the control of the Club, as mentioned in Section 2. Such members shall be Honorary Members of the Club during such time as they are assisting in events under the control of the Competition Secretary or his/her assistants.

8. LIFE MEMBERSHIP

Any member of ten (10) years in good standing, who has rendered the Club meritorious service may be elected by a ballot, a Life Member, at an annual General Meeting, by a seven eighths (7/8) majority of members voting at such meeting. Any member wishing to nominate a member for Life Membership must do so fourteen (14) days before the Annual General Meeting. The nomination must state the date of entry into the Club by the member nominated, and services rendered. The nominator must have had at least five (5) years service with the Club. A Life Member shall enjoy all the privileges of the Club.

9. THE COMMITTEE

- a. The Committee of the Club shall consist of the Officers of the Club, together with up to five (5) financial full members from the rank and file of the Club members.
- b. The Committee shall manage the affairs of the Club, subject to the control of the members at general meetings.
- c. Any matter on which these rules are silent, and which is brought before the Committee shall be determined by that Committee and any such resolution shall be binding on all members subject to no amendment being carried out in accordance with Section sixteen (16).
- d. Members of the Committee shall hold office for the period of one year, at the termination of which such members shall be eligible for re-election.
- e. Should any office or place in the Committee become vacant for any reason whatsoever, the vacancy shall be filled by election as soon as practicable at a general meeting.

10. OFFICERS OF THE CLUB

- a. Officers of the Club shall consist of the President, Vice-President, Honorary Secretary, Minutes Secretary, Honorary Treasurer, Competition Secretary, Social Secretary, Captain, and the Public Officer.
- b. Officers shall hold office for the period of one (1) year, at the termination of which, such Officers shall be eligible for re-election.

11. COMMON SEAL

- a. There shall be a Common Seal of the Club, which shall bear the name of the Club. The Common Seal shall be held in the custody of the Seal Holders.
- b. The Seal Holders shall be the President and the Honorary Secretary of the Club.
- c. The persons authorised to use the Common Seal are the two (2) Seal Holders, in the presence of some other person, who shall be a member of the Committee, provided that the Common Seal shall not be used except pursuant to a resolution of the Committee.

12. POWER OF SUSPENSION OR EXPULSION

- a. Any member may be expelled from the Club or suspended in any manner what-so-ever upon the vote of a two thirds (2/3) majority of the financial full members present at a general meeting.
- b. Any Office Holder or any Member of the Committee may be removed from Office or from the Committee as the case may be, upon the vote of a two thirds (2/3) majority of the financial full members present at a general meeting.
